

Level 3 Food & Drink Maintenance Engineer Apprenticeship



Course Overview

A Maintenance Engineer works within the Food and Drink Industry, where some companies use the most innovative, modern and technically automated equipment to manufacture a huge range of food and drink products.

Food and Drink Maintenance Engineers maintain machinery and equipment in the industry, finding and resolving faults in order to optimise production levels.

All maintenance activities must be conducted safely and comply with food safety legislation.

Apprenticeships give you the opportunity to work for a real employer, earn a real salary and gain a real qualification whilst gaining valuable workplace skills and experience. If you are aged 16 or above, are driven to succeed in a particular industry and are willing to commit yourself to training and study, then an Apprenticeship could be the right career move for you.

What You Will Study

The apprentice will learn, work, earn and achieve a qualification all at the same time.

To achieve the apprenticeship they will complete the following:

- An industry designed and recognised apprenticeship
- End Point Assessment (Written Knowledge Test, Practical Tests and Professional Dialogue and Interview)

The apprentice will work towards the following Functional Skills:

- Mathematics up to Level 2
- English up to Level 2

Learners who have already achieved GCSEs (9-4/A*-C or equivalent) in Maths and English may be exempt from Functional Skills.

How You Will Be Assessed

Written Knowledge Test, Practical Tests and Professional Dialogue and Interview
