

# NVQ Diploma Trowel Occupations (Construction) - Bricklaying



## Course Overview

This Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Trowel Occupations (Construction) qualification is suitable for those who are employed working with or as a bricklayer.

This qualification enables you, to recognise your skills, knowledge and understanding as well as demonstrate your competence in the workplace when carrying out the role of a bricklayer.

You will learn through formal delivery in the college environment both in the classroom and the practical workshop. This will supplement the learning that is taking place in the workplace.

## What You Will Study

This Bricklaying qualification supports you to attain enabling, fundamental and transferable practical skills with associated underpinning knowledge.

You will learn key practical skills and knowledge in these mandatory and optional units. The mandatory elements are:

- Conforming to General Health, Safety and Welfare in the Workplace
- Conforming to Productive Working practices in the Workplace
- Erecting Masonry structures in the Workplace
- Moving, Handling and Storing Resources in the Workplace
- Setting out to form masonry structures in the Workplace

## Attendance Expectations

This qualification can be attended on a day release basis, attending one day per week expected to be a Friday.

Alternatively, attendance can be one evening per week expected to be a Monday evening, with a block week in December and a further block week in January.

You will be assessed against a set of performance and knowledge statements which have been derived from National Occupational Standards for your occupational area (Recommended Qualification Structure (RQS) for Trowel Occupations (Construction))
