



Skills Bootcamp - Construction Site Operative



Course Overview

This first-of-its-kind short-course is designed to provide learners with the knowledge, skills behaviours, and attitudes to work as general site operatives within the construction sector. The expectation of the programme is that it will support progression into employment.

Benefits of studying Site Operative Bricklaying:

- Develop bricklaying skills and knowledge in line with the apprenticeship standard
- All those attending will have the opportunity to achieve a Level 1 Award in Health and Safety and CSCS Green card
- Guaranteed job interview with one of our employer partners who are looking to recruit new Construction Site Operatives

What You Will Study

Delivered within Castleford College's purpose-built Brick Workshop, learners will have the opportunity to be in an environment that simulates the conditions of a construction site. Theory will be introduced in the classroom environment and will be embedded throughout practical activities. The course will be delivered over four weeks.

- Health and Safety (supporting CSCS test and card on successful completion of programme)
- Brick Walling
- Cavity Walling
- Interview Techniques
